Leviticus: Israel's Code of Priestly Service and Holiness: One of the most important books of the Old Testament, since it lays the theological foundation for the New Testament teaching about the atoning work of Jesus Christ. It reveals the OT nature and purpose of the law. The law was the constitution of the nation of Israel, it revealed what was required to be in communion with God, it regulated the worship and purity of the people of God, and was a pedagogue leading to Christ. Understanding Future Events: This study will cover such topics as the Holy Spirit and Satan, as well as discussing future events, and will be led by Bob Post in Room D130.

What's Your Plan: 48 Days to the Work You Love: Led by Mel Gower in Room D132. This study is packed with modern insight and timeless wisdom; here is a step-by-step process for creating a Life Plan and translating it into meaningful, satisfying daily work.
